Week 22

Opening:

What is one low (a bad thing) and one high (a good thing) that happened to you this past week? Write them down and take turns sharing them with the others in your group.

Where have you seen the work of the Holy Spirit in your life this past week?

When was the first time that you encountered prejudice? How did you feel at the time? How did it impact your life?

Preparation:

Spend 1-2 minutes in silence with God to center and prepare yourself for your time with God today.

Read:

Read <u>Acts 10</u> out loud.

What words, phrases, or ideas grabbed your attention and heart in these verses?

Respond / Reflect:

Are there some types of people (ethnically, socially, economically, politically, age wise, etc.) who would not be welcome in your church or your home? Are there some practices you could change to remove those barriers? How would you feel about making those changes?

If God lowered a sheet in your dreams...who or what might be in it?

What are your prejudices? Can you identify them? Admit them? Address them?

What walls in our families, church, school, neighborhood, community, or city need to be broken? What bridges need to be built?

Where might we be saying "No" to God for the sake of "tradition?"

Are we willing to embrace God's preferred future by embracing people who are not just like us?

Missional Practice for the Month: Wall Breaking / Bridge Building
