The Reading of the Law: The Third Commandment (Exodus 20:7)

You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God, for the Lord will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses His name.

Heidelberg Catechism Q&A 99

Q. What is the aim of the third commandment?

A. **That we neither blaspheme nor misuse the name of God by cursing, perjury, or unnecessary oaths, nor share in such horrible sins by being silent bystanders.**
In summary,
we should use the holy name of God only with reverence and awe, so that we may properly confess God, pray to God, and glorify God in all our words and works.
