Opening:

Write them down below and/or share them with those who are with you.

Respond / Reflect:
Are you choosing what matters? How do you know?
Do you think it is harder to live when you have a lot or a little? Why?
If your house caught on fire and your family and pets were safe, what three possessions would you try and save from the fire?
How do you define greed?
In planning an investment portfolio to become "rich toward God," what will you do / include?
In your own words, what is the punch line of this parable?

Spend time in prayer with/for the other people who are with you. Pray this prayer together:
